He sniffed the runner's hand. He was easy to remove and he moderately pulled on leash. In the catch pen when he was introduced to the dogs his body was neutral, his eyes were neutral and his tail was low with no wag. He was easy to collar and leash. He entered the yard and ignored the dogs. He roamed quietly and sniffed his environmental surroundings. He ran away from the handler anytime she walked over to him. He was interested in the dogs, he watched them play. He sniffed and exchanged appropriate greetings with the dogs in the yard with him. He was able to co-exist with the dogs. Overall, Chomper was tolerant of the dogs and does not have a playstyle at this time. See handling assessment.

He allowed the handler to pet him, he was nervous but displayed no aggression during his handling. He anxiously paced the yard. The longer the handler pet him the more he settled. Chomper will require confidence building, continued socialization, and slow introductions. Please advise interested parties that he will require a handler who is experienced and familiar with his breed. Behaviorally ok for public adoption, adults only required, calm large dogs recommended.
