Pre-anesthetic: Ampicillin 200mg/ml: 0.31 cc SQ,

Induction: Telazol (100 mg/ml) 0.15 cc IM / gas down w/ ISO + O2

Maintenance: Oxygen 2L Isoflurane 1%

Monitoring: Pulse oximeter

Supportive care: Thermoregulation pad/blanket

A scrotal incision was made over the left testicle and the testicle was exteriorized . The subcutaneous tissue was removed.

The cord, cremaster, and vessels were then tied on themselves and the testicle removed distal to the knot. This was repeated for the right testicle.
